COLLEGE AND CAREER ENRICHMENT

Established in 2014, Academies of Hospitality and Tourism are located within Ballou HS, Bell Multicultural HS at Columbia Heights Educational Campus, Woodrow Wilson HS, and Maya Angelou Public Charter School. Students in grades 9-12 follow the National Academy Foundation program and emphasize strong college and industry partnerships, work-based learning experiences and rigorous curricula that culminate in an industry-recognized certification at graduation.

SCHOLARSHIPS

AEF provides scholarships to students or graduates from the DC Hospitality Academies pursuing higher education for a career in the hospitality industry. Scholarships may be applied to college and university, technical/trade school or certificate programs.
